

## Winterizing/Absence Checklist

Whether this is your first or 20th winter away from your condo, whether you will be gone three weeks or six months, please consider using the following checklist:

Complete the "Extended Absence Form" available on the website, listing a local
contact person who has a key if the board should need emergency access to
your condo. This contact person should be willing to make inspections of your
condo to assure you all is as you left it.
By November 1, your deck and patio should be cleared of all furniture and other
items, everything except a grill.
Winterize your outside faucets by turning off the shut-off valve, opening the
faucet to drain any residual water, and then close the faucet. This will protect
your water lines from freezing.
Do <b>NOT</b> turn off the "Master Building Water Shut Off Valve," if you have this, as
this valve supplies water to your neighbors as well. Only one unit per building has
this valve.
Turn down the thermostat to your furnace to 50-55 degrees to maintain some
heat in your condo to prevent freezing of water lines.
Adjust your furnace damper from "A/C" to "Heat", turn on the water supply to the
humidifier, and turn on your humidifier to no higher than "30" to allow some
humidity in your condo. Do not set it higher as this will put too much humidity in
your condo and cause condensation on your windows, causing mold and rot of
the window frames.
Turn your water heater control to the "Vacation" or "Low" setting to reduce costs
and use of natural gas.
Turn off the water supply to your clothes washer, dishwasher, and ice maker.
Notify the Post Office and newspaper delivery services of a delivery hold or
forwarding address information.
Lock all windows and doors, including slider doors and garage service door
